



The 10x10 resolution “Reducing electricity and fossil fuel consumption 10 percent each by 2010”

January-September 2010 Scorecard

Fuel

- All combined fuel sources = down 12%

Gasoline

- All Down 36%
- County = down 13% (\$11,642 savings)
- Joint Departments = down 48% (\$17,443 savings)
- Town = down 40% (\$26,597 savings)

Diesel

- All Down 10%
- Town = down 40% (\$15,512 savings)

Natural Gas

- All Up 2%
- Existing County Facilities = down 15%
- Town = down 12%

Propane

- All Down 9%
- Joint Departments = down 23%
- Town = down 26%

Fuel Oil

- All Down 18%
- County Administration Building converted to Natural Gas, eliminates use of fuel oil

Electricity:

- All facilities = up 1%
- All existing facilities since 2006= down 2%
- All facilities except wastewater treatment and water production = down 7%
- All existing County facilities since 2006= down 10% (\$8,770.00 savings)
- All existing Joint Dept facilities since 2006 = down 12% (\$7, 848.00 savings)
- All existing Town facilities since 2006 = down 29% (\$8, 858.00 savings)
- TOTAL existing facilities since 2006= down 14%
