This month's newsletter is dedicated to Survey Results and Data.

Survey Results

10 X 10 SURVEY RESULTS:

- 36% said you were carpooling to work.
- 8% of you are riding the START Bus regularly.
- 13% are walking to work and 14% ride your bike to work

When asked what changes you are making.....

- 25% are biking more; 36% of you are walking more.
- 50% of you are reducing the amount you drive with 48% of you combining errand and tasks into one car trip.

Other Changes you are making.....

- 76% of you are turning off lights & equipment regularly.
- 12% have stopped using your personal space heater.

The #1 reported change in the office is recycling of materials from reusing office supplies to using non-disposable kitchen supplies.

Here are a few things we have learned from your responses:

- 89% of you made changes to help achieve the 10 x 10 goal.
- 36% said that tracking our progress would help them be more energy efficient.

- 59% want to hear about 10 x 10 from website or e-mails.
- 20% want to hear more about 10x10 from their supervisors.
- Overall as individuals you see the benefit of 10 x 10 as being BOTH economic and environmental.

In response, we are doing the following:

- Making our progress available from any town or county computer at <http://10x10jh> and meeting with departments to show them their progress
- Providing supervisors with support, data and training tools for their discussion and implementation of 10x10 in their work groups.

Where were we at the end of 2008?

Electricity (kWh) = Up 1% from 2006

All Fuels (BTU) = Up 5% from 2006

Why?

- 1) We added almost 200,000 kWh with the new Parking Garage. Without the garage we would be down 1%.
- 2) Big snow events this winter (45 inches in December alone) meant big diesel use for 2008. Also natural gas was up significantly from 2006.

2009 Data

Did You Know... that Public Works has decreased their gasoline consumption by **29.58%** and diesel by **27.91%** since the first of the year!!! Way to GO!!!

Remember you can access the 10 x 10 data anytime on a Town or County computer just type in <http://10x10jh> and click enter.

Did You Know.... The Recreation Center electric usage is down 16.11 % compared to Feb of 2008 and has used 19.29 % less natural gas than this same time last year!!!!

Did You Know... that the Admin Bldg at Jackson Hole Fire /EMS has decreased their electricity use by 25.58% compared to February of last year? And their **Natural Gas usage by 39.45% !!**
