

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular meeting on **July 18, 2022** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:02 a.m.

Commission present: Natalia Macker, Chairwoman, Luther Propst, Vice-Chairman, Mark Barron, and Mark Newcomb were present in-person, and Greg Epstein was present online via Zoom.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Propst to adopt the agenda as presented. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Public comment was given by Ethan Lobdell regarding the Children's Museum possibly moving in the Merrill Building.

**ACTION ITEMS**

1. Consideration of Payment of County Vouchers

A motion was made by Commissioner Newcomb and seconded by Commissioner Propst to approve the July 18, 2022 county voucher run in the amount of \$ 1,084,374.70. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

2. Consideration of Administrative Items

a. 24-Hour Liquor Permits

i. JH Still Works / Fire in the Mountains

A request for approval of an application for a 24-Hour Manufacturer's Off-Premise Permit submitted by Jackson Hole Still Works for Fire in the Mountains to be held July 22 - 24, 2022.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Propst to approve the 24-hour manufacturer's off-premise permit submitted by Jackson Hole Still Works for Fire in the Mountains to take place at the Heart Six Ranch, Moran, WY on July 22 - 24, 2022 with the permit being valid for a 24-hour period per day. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

ii. Beartrap Ciderworks LLC / Fire in the Mountains

A request for approval of an application for a 24-hour winery off-premise permit submitted by Beartrap Ciderworks LLC for Fire in the Mountains to be held July 22-24, 2022.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Propst to approve the 24-hour manufacturer's off-premise permit submitted by Beartrap Ciderworks LLC for Fire in the Mountains to take place at the Heart Six Ranch, Moran, WY on July 22-24, 2022 with the permit being valid for a 24-hour period per day. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

iii. Teatonic Kombucha LLC / Fire in the Mountains

A request for approval of an application for a 24-hour malt beverage Picnic Permit submitted by the Teatonic Kombucha LLC for Fire in the Mountains to be held July 22-24, 2022.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Propst to approve the 24-hour malt beverage picnic permit submitted by Teatonic Kombucha, LLC for Fire in the Mountains to take place at the Heart Six Ranch, Moran, WY on July 22-24, 2022 with the permit being valid for a 24-hour period per day. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

b. SLIB Drawdown

i. Drawdowns for Fire Station #1

Requests for acceptance of State Loan and Investment Board (SLIB Grant) Contracts with Teton County for construction and engineering of Fire Station 1.

A motion was made by Commissioner Propst and seconded by Commissioner Barron to approve the agreement with State of Wyoming State Loan and Investment Board for \$161,621.00 to reimburse Teton County for construction costs of Fire Station 1, and, to approve the agreement with State of Wyoming State Loan and Investment Board for \$32,324.20 to reimburse Teton County for engineering costs of Fire Station 1. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

The County is currently leasing a helicopter for eight months out of the year and seeks either a year-round lease, or ownership of a helicopter for Search and Rescue and emergency response purposes.

At today’s meeting, the Board requested additional information from Staff. Matt Carr, Teton County Sheriff, answered questions from the Board.

**D. Letter from the Town of Jackson – Local Funding for Stilson Transit Center BUILD Project**

The Board discussed a letter from the Town of Jackson regarding funding for the Stilson Transit Center. This item will be added to the agenda for the next regular Joint Information Meeting with the Town of Jackson.
