

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met virtually in a special meeting on **September 2, 2021** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 8:15 a.m.

Commission present: Natalia Macker, Chairwoman, Luther Propst, Vice-Chairman, Greg Epstein, Mark Barron, and Mark Newcomb were present via Zoom.

CONSIDERATION OF EXTENSION OF PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER #21-5

Jodie Pond, Health Director, presented to the Board for consideration of approval the Order Affirming and Extending Public Health Order #21-5 for the Unincorporated Area of Teton County, Wyoming.

Dr. Riddell, the Teton District Health Officer, issued Teton District Health Order #21-5 on August 26, 2021, requiring individuals to wear face coverings certain place, with exceptions. Pursuant to Wyoming Statute §35-1-310, any order issued by a district health officer that restricts individuals' movements or their ability to engage in any activity, that applies to individuals not under an isolation or quarantine order and that is designed to prevent or limit the transmission of a contagious or possibly contagious disease shall be effective for a period of not more than ten (10) days. Subsequent orders, including order extensions, for the same or substantially same purpose of any duration shall only be issued if the governing body of a political subdivision that is a member of the health district or the district health department, by a majority vote of the governing body, issues an order subsequent to the order issued by the district health officer.

Paul Beaupre, COVID Response Director, answered questions from the Board.

Public comment was given by Maury Jones and Gloria Courser.

A motion was made by Commissioner Propst and seconded by Commissioner Newcomb to approve the Order Affirming and Extending Public Health Order #21-5 for the Unincorporated Area of Teton County, Wyoming. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed three in favor and the motion carried 3-2 with Commissioners Barron and Epstein opposed.

ADJOURN

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to adjourn. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
