





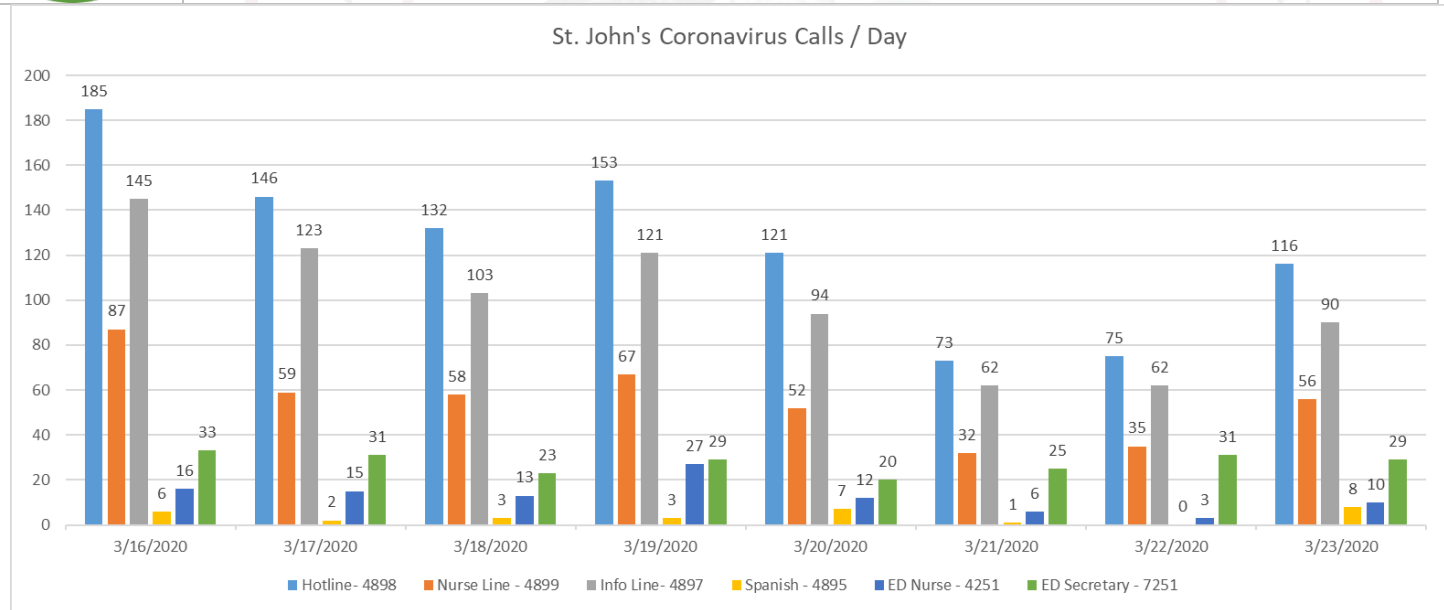

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teton County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) activated to Stage 2 – Partial Activation. • Teton County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) partially activated with ESF#05 Emergency Management, ESF#6 Mass Care, ESF#8 Public Health, and ESF#15 External Affairs. • Multiple agencies throughout the valley have incident management teams in place for COVID-19. • Town of Jackson has <u>reduced non-critical services</u> in response to COVID-19. • Effective 3/23/20 through 4/3/20 public access shall be restricted to all <u>Teton County Government Buildings</u>. Any member of the public seeking service from a County Office shall call or email the office directly. • <u>Teton County Attorney</u> issues fraud alert regarding COVID-19 scams.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>JHCOVID.COM</u> has been launched by community partners as a one stop shop for all information regarding the pandemic locally. • Community Foundation of JH has activated their <u>Community Emergency Response Fund</u> to support local nonprofits directly impacted by COVID-19. • <u>St. John's Health Foundation</u> launches COVID-19 Response Fund for SJH employees impacted by COVID-19 • One22 has activated their <u>COVID-19 Financial Relief Grants</u> for individuals affected by COVID-19. • <u>JH Food Help</u> webpage has been set up to include all resources for food assistance. • <u>DishingJH</u> has created an alternate dining options list. • <u>Teton County School District</u>: <u>During Spring Break, Hole Food Rescue will provide meals at JH High School from 11am-1pm, Monday through Friday. On 3/23/20 Hole Food Rescue distributed 61 lunches.</u>

See their <u>website</u> for information. • <u>Global COVID-19</u>: 372,757 confirmed (39,827 new) cases & 16,231 deaths (1,722). • <u>US COVID-19</u>: 33,404 (10,779 new) cases & 544 (144 new) deaths. • <u>WY COVID-19</u>: 30 cases (4 new) & 0 deaths. <u>Cases are located</u> in Sheridan, Carbon, Fremont, Natrona, Laramie, Campbell, Park & Teton Counties. • <u>Total tests completed</u> in Wyoming 739: Public Health Lab – 567, Commercial labs – 171, CDC – 1. • <u>St. John's Health daily statistics</u> for COVID-19 from 03/23/20: 5 COVID-19 tests submitted (N/A), 86 COVID-19 tests submitted to date (+5), 66 Telehealth visits (+51), 116 COVID hotline calls (+41), 3,002 Visits to St. John's Health coronavirus webpage (+258). • <u>Teton County WY COVID-19</u>: 2 cases & 0 deaths. • <u>Teton County, Idaho</u> number of confirmed cases 2. • State of Wyoming has issued <u>two State Public Health Orders</u> the first deals with closures of certain establishments and restaurants, the second forbids gatherings of 10 people or more unless exempted. <u>Today a Third State Public Health Order</u> was issued temporarily closing nail salons, hair salons, barber shops, massage parlors, tattoo, body art and piercing shops and cosmetology, electrology and esthetic services. • <u>St. John's Health</u> continues to use alternate processes for screening. Call 307-739-4898, option 3 if you have fever, cough, or influenza-like illness for a phone evaluation. • Teton County Health Officer issued Teton District Public <u>Health Order 20-1</u> forbidding Large Gatherings over 50 People & <u>Health Order 20-2</u> closing certain establishments and restaurants. Health Officer issues <u>Exception Order #1</u> regarding Snow King. • <u>WY Department of Family Services</u> has released a map of childcare providers open during the COVID crisis that can provide childcare to essential service workers. • <u>Parks & Recreation</u> is making adjustments to programs and hours based on COVID-19. 3/17/20 • <u>Teton County Library</u> is closed until further notice. updated 3/16/20 • <u>Teton County School District #1</u> schools closed from Monday March 16th through April 5th, 2020. • <u>Teton Science Schools</u>, including Mountain Academy, are suspended through 4/10/20. • <u>Teton County Health Department</u> activated COVID-19 hotline 307-732-8628 on 3/5/20. • <u>Jackson Hole Community School</u> is closed until April 13.
