	<p><b>Message from Unified Command 03/30/20:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is going to get worse before it gets better. Please follow all Public Health Orders, Recommendations and the Town Ordinance. Please do your part. This is how we will flatten the curve in Teton County.</li> <li>• We need to continue to prepare for the worst and work for the best. Thank you to all who have come together to prepare our community during this response.</li> <li>• We can make a difference as an individual, and a community by 1) help promote physical distancing; 2) If you are sick with a cough or respiratory symptoms, stay home. Assume you have COVID-19 disease. We have community spread in Teton County, act in ways that protect your own health and the health of your fellow citizens.</li> <li>• This too shall pass, how long it lasts is up to each one of us.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="http://JHCOVID.COM">JHCOVID.COM</a> has been launched as a one stop shop for all information regarding the pandemic locally, <a href="http://jhcovidespanol.com">jhcovidespanol.com</a> a Spanish version of this site has now also been launched.</li> <li>• Community Foundation of JH has activated their <a href="#">Community Emergency Response Fund</a> to support local nonprofits directly impacted by COVID-19.</li> <li>• <a href="#">St. John's Health Foundation</a> launches COVID-19 Response Fund for SJH employees.</li> <li>• One22 has activated their <a href="#">COVID-19 Financial Relief Grants</a> for individuals affected by COVID-19.</li> <li>• <a href="#">JH Food Help</a> webpage has been set up to include all resources for food assistance.</li> <li>• <a href="#">DishingJH</a> has created an alternate dining options list.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Teton County School District</a>: During Spring Break, Hole Food Rescue will provide meals at JH High School from 11am-1pm, Monday through Friday. On 3/27/20 they distributed 62 lunches (-16).</li> <li>• <a href="#">Teton County School District</a> buildings and grounds are presently closed - except for the West parking lot at the High School for public access to the meals program. This closure includes fields, playgrounds, skate park and other assets located on District property. While TCSD understands the desire of families to access recreational spaces, TCSD does not have the staff resources available at present to support the opening, cleaning or maintenance of any District Facilities.</li> <li>• JH Chamber of Commerce is maintaining a <a href="#">Status of Lodging in Jackson Hole</a> spreadsheet available to the public.</li> </ul>

County <a href="#">Public Health Order #20-3</a> issued requiring stay at home order of older adults, including an <a href="#">easy-to-read explanation</a> of the order.</li> <li>• County Health Officer issues <a href="#">Public Health Recommendations #5 and #6</a> for all residents of Teton County, recommending all residents, regardless of age, stay home except for essential purposes and for those that leave the geographic area to quarantine for 14 days.</li> <li>• Town approves <a href="#">Emergency Ordinance 1249</a> requiring town residents to stay at home within the Town of Jackson only, while allowing essential businesses and activities to continue.</li> <li>• Wyoming Department of Health article on <a href="#">Protecting Mental Health During Stressful Times</a>.</li> </ul>
