	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teton County/Jackson COVID Unified Command reminds the public that if they <u>have symptoms</u> such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or repeated shaking with chills to call your doctor or St. John's Health at 307-739-4898 to be evaluated and possibly tested. Testing capacity is increasing every day, and restrictions on who can be tested have been reduced.</li> <li>• Town of Jackson <u>continues to discourage</u> antler shed hunters from coming to Jackson for opening day due to COVID-19 concerns.</li> <li>• <u>St. John's Health will be giving out cloth face coverings to the public at Smith's on Thursday, April 30, 2020 from 2-4pm and Friday, May 1, 2020 from 9-11am.</u></li> <li>• Teton County voted to <u>extend public access restrictions</u> at all County buildings through May 4, 2020.</li> <li>• <u>Statewide public health orders</u> were updated on 4/28 and will be effective on 5/1 through 5/15 by the State Health Officer.</li> <li>• <u>Starting the week of 5/4, the Situation Report will be produced once a week on Wednesdays.</u></li> <li>• Teton County <u>COVID Dashboards</u> have been updated with new graphs, indicators, and statistics to include probable cases in total case counts.</li> </ul>

It is updated often, so check it frequently.
