	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teton County/Jackson COVID Unified Command reminds the public that if they <u>have symptoms</u> such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or repeated shaking with chills to call your doctor or St. John's Health at 307-739-4898 to be evaluated and possibly tested. Testing capacity is increasing every day, and restrictions on who can be tested have been reduced.</li> <li>• Teton County voted to <u>extend public access restrictions</u> at all County buildings through May 4, 2020.</li> <li>• Starting the week of 5/4, the Situation Report will be produced once a week on Wednesdays.</li> <li>• <u>Teton County School District</u> announced that all schools will remain closed through at least May 15th.</li> </ul>
