	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teton County/Jackson COVID Unified Command reminds the public that if they <u>have symptoms</u> such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or repeated shaking with chills to call your doctor or St. John's Health at 307-739-4898 to be evaluated and possibly tested. Testing capacity is increasing every day, and restrictions on who can be tested have been reduced. Teton County voted to <u>extend public access restrictions</u> at all County buildings through May 18, 2020. COVID Community Update on Friday May 8th at 3:00pm live streamed from Jackson Town Hall. Teton County School District announced that all schools will remain closed through at least May 15th.

It is updated often, so check it frequently. New reusable and washable cloth shopping bags are available to the public for free at the entrance of Town Hall at 150 E Pearl Ave in the breezeway. Teton County Parks and Recreation is now offering <u>free showers</u> every day of the week from 9am to 3pm. Teton County Health Department in conjunction with the JH Chamber of Commerce's Economic Recovery Task Force released guidance for the general public and businesses for recovery.
