- Teton County voted to extend public access restrictions at all County buildings through May 18, 2020.

- [JHCOVID.COM](#) is the official one-stop shop for all information regarding the pandemic locally, along with its sister site [jhcovidspanol.com](#). The site includes resources for food assistance, lodging accepting those that need to isolate or quarantine, ways you can help or donate to help the COVID cause, links to the Teton County COVID Information Dashboards, and more. It is updated often, so check it frequently.
- New reusable and washable cloth shopping bags are available to the public for free at the entrance of Town Hall at 150 E Pearl Ave in the breezeway.
- Teton County Parks and Recreation continues to offer free showers every day of the week from 9am to 3pm.
- [Teton County School District](#) has begun distributing meals to anyone under the age of 19 for weekends as well as weekdays by providing extra meals on Fridays to last through the weekend. Meals can be picked up at JH High School M-F 7:30a to 2:30p.

- [Teton Health District Recommendation #7](#) remains in effect, recommending that individuals wear cloth face coverings while in public.
- [Teton County School District](#) has been approved for their Phase 1 reopening plan that provides supervision for 180 kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students at Colter Elementary as they work through their Adapted Learning Plan. See [TCSD website](#) for latest information.
