

TETON COUNTY/JACKSON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT (TCJPR) - COVID19 Health Operating Plan [May 11, 2020]

Purpose:	The purpose of the plan is to re-introduce facilities, services and programs to the public in a manner consistent with the Teton County Public Health Guidance System. Teton County/Jackson Parks and Recreation Department are committed to following all local recommended health guidelines, and will take a conservative approach to place public health and safety at the forefront of all decisions.			
Application:	TCJPR will adjust operations and programs based upon the direction of Teton County Public Health and the Teton County Public Health Officer. At the relaxation of each health order, TCJPR operations and programs will only be modified upon the completion of all necessary infrastructure, staffing and supplies necessary to ensure community safety. Upon an health order change, TCJPR will provide to the elected officials and the community at large detailed schedules for the department's changes and openings to facilities, services and programs.			
Color-Coded Health Guidance System	<p>Red (High Risk)</p> <p>The level of guidance Teton County is functioning under right now. Teton District Health Order #20-4 limits gatherings to only individuals who live in your household and allows for a person to perform certain tasks and activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Perform tasks essential to their health and safety, or for the health and safety of their household members or pets, including, but not limited to, obtaining medical supplies or medication or visiting a health care professional. Care for a family member or pet in another household. *Obtain necessary supplies for self or household members (including, but not limited to, groceries, food, liquor, sporting goods, and products necessary to maintain the safety, sanitation, and essential operation of a residence). *Deliver necessary supplies (including, but not limited to, groceries, food, liquor, sporting goods, and products necessary to maintain for safety, sanitation, and essential operation of a residence). *Engage in outdoor activity, so long as six (6) feet is maintained between any person not in the same household. *Travel to and work at a place of employment, if the work cannot be done remotely from home. <p>Orange & Yellow (Moderate and Low) The level of the requirements will reflect the level of risk to public health and may include the following at a minimum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Increased hygiene of staff and employees *Mandatory cloth face coverings *Physical distancing (separation of 6 feet or more) *Required symptom checking and restriction of sick employees *Increased cleaning and disinfecting procedures *Required messaging *Rotating staff schedules or teleworking <p>Green (New Normal) The level of the requirements will reflect the level of risk to public health and may include the following at a minimum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Increased hygiene of staff and employees *Mandatory cloth face coverings *Physical distancing (separation of 6 feet or more) *Required symptom checking and restriction of sick employees *Increased cleaning and disinfecting procedures *Required messaging *Rotating staff schedules or teleworking 			
	<p>Each color-coded level requires Teton County Residents to adhere to these rules of conduct:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Common Sense and Personal Responsibility – The Teton County Health Guidance Plan cannot anticipate every unique situation. Residents and businesses must take personal responsibility to be informed and take actions based on common sense. Protective Hygiene and Disinfecting – Teton County Residents must practice protective hygiene and disinfection regimens to minimize the risk of exposure to COVID-19. These include but are not limited to the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds as frequently as feasible Use hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol based) when soap and water are not available Cover cough or sneeze into the elbow or sleeve, not hands Regularly disinfect high-touch surfaces (buttons, door handles, counters, etc.) Avoid touching your face Refrain from hand shaking Wear a cloth face covering in public when you cannot maintain the 6 foot physical distance spacing. Follow Guidance – Public health and economic opportunity are intrinsically linked. Teton County Residents and Businesses must follow the Teton County health guidance for each color or risk backtracking and causing greater economic harm. High-risk Populations – High-risk populations and those around them must follow a specific set of instructions issued by the Teton County Health Department.

[Aquatics]		<p>*Open up Recreation Center to Lap Swimming only under a reservation system 6am- 2pm Monday- Friday. *All kickboards and pull buoys used during each hour must be disinfected before being returned to the bin. *Steam room, sauna, and hot tub will remain closed due to lack of social distancing availability. *Reservation system shall limit 8 swimmers per 2 hour block. If it is after June 15 the pool will follow the summer pool schedule. *Tot swim and family swim can resume. *Aquatics staff will go through the pool area and locker rooms every hour to disinfect all door handles, faucets, and hand rails. *All pool equipment (kneelocks, kickboards, pull buoys, etc) will be disinfected each night at closing</p>
[Aquatic Programming]	Closed	<p>*No swim lessons, swim team, family swim or any other programs will be held.</p>	<p>*No Swim lessons, swim team, family swim or any other programs will be held in the green phase. *Water fitness may choose to return with a maximum of 10 people in the slide pool in order to adhere to social distancing guidelines. If they return, they will come at the half hour point so lap swimmers and water aerobics are not arriving or leaving at the same time.</p>	<p>*Swim lessons and swim team can begin. *Water fitness can return to their normal size classes (or they can begin doing classes again if they did not restart in yellow). *All water aerobics equipment will be disinfected before being returned to their racks. *All swim lesson equipment and toys will be disinfected daily after the morning and again after the evening swim lessons. *Swim team is responsible for disinfecting and taking care of all of their equipment.</p>
