

# Teton WY EOC Community Lifeline SitRep #041



- Teton County Government buildings will reopen to the public on May 26, 2020 with the exception of the Teton County Courthouse, which will reopen to the public on June 1, 2020.
- Teton County/Town of Jackson Unified Command has been allowed to stand down as our community moves into the Stabilization phase. The Teton County Emergency Operations Center remains activated to Stage 2 – Partial Activation.



- JHCOVID.COM is the official one-stop shop for all information regarding the pandemic locally, along with its sister site jhcovid espanol.com. The site includes resources for food assistance, lodging accepting those that need to isolate or quarantine, ways you can help or donate to help the COVID cause, links to the Teton County COVID Information Dashboards, and more. It is updated often, so check it frequently.
- New reusable and washable cloth shopping bags are available to the public for free at the entrance of Town Hall at 150 E Pearl Ave in the breezeway.
- Teton County Parks and Recreation continues to offer free showers every day of the week from 9am to 3pm.
- Teton County School District continues to distribute meals to anyone under the age of 19. Meals can be picked up at JH High School M-F 7:30a to 2:30p.

- Teton County Health Department is hosting a COVID-19 Mass Active Disease Testing Event on Thursday May 28<sup>th</sup> from 9am to 7pm at the Teton County Fairgrounds. Free vouchers for the uninsured and under-insured will be available. Others should bring their insurance card. Asymptomatic people will be able to get tested.
- The current COVID Risk Level for Teton County is Moderate/Orange. Visit the Teton County Health Department website for current risk level and to view the Roadmap to Recovery Plan.
- Teton Health District Recommendation #7 remains in effect, recommending that individuals wear cloth face coverings while in public.
