- I. **Call to Order:** Rich Ochs called the meeting to order at 8:32.
- II. **Around the Room Introductions:** Rich went around the room and did introductions.
- III. **Approval of March LEPC Meeting Minutes:** Rich Ochs asked for a motion to approve the November LEPC meeting minutes. Tom Ninnemann made the motion, and Kristen Waters seconded the motion. No discussion. They were approved unanimously.
- IV. **COVID-19 Updates:** Rachael Wheeler provided updates on current COVID situation in Teton county and plans for vaccine distribution.

 - Currently accepting vaccine registration for 75 and older. Hoping to open to 70 and older next week.
 - 307-732-8628 is the local COVID hotline number.
 - Adding new color above RED to try to show community are we are at.
 - Will reach out to sub-group 5 in the next week or so.
 - Limited number of vaccines.
 - Wear a three layer or thicker mask to prevent the spread.
 - Johnson and Johnson have a one dose vaccine that may be approved in February.

- V. **Around the Room** Emergency Operations just starting hosting Health Department at EOC. Established a Health Department incident command post. Check out Teton County Weather Decision Support for more Weather information. Jackson Hole Fire/EMS continues to transport COVID patients regularly. PPE is in good shape except for N95s which are running low. School District continue to provide Vault tests. COVID numbers are down this week from last week. The School Board has monthly meetings to discuss path. Reviewed class schedules. Elementary goes Monday through Thursday, Middle and High school alternate two days with virtual on Fridays. The board did a virtual listening session in English and then in a Spanish. The Spanish speaking families were very engaged with this format. Planning is in the early stages of Northern South Park planning. Will have public outreach in the next month or two. Are doing some code enforcement on a Helicopter flying low in Hoback area. H1 site at Teton Village are going through building permit reviews now. This will be a large project starting in summer. News and Guide has been mostly working remotely and getting the word out. Jackson Public Works is having a busy year with ice mitigation. Working with Flat Creek Water district to prevent flooding. American Airlines is heavily reliant on all participants. Sunday and Monday are the busiest days otherwise 30-40 load capacity. Teton County PIO is working closely with the Health Department to get the word out. Have Shred the Spread masks. Teton County would like to do a picnic late summer for the centennial. Email Kwaters@tetoncountywy.gov with any ideas or to participate. Teton County Dispatch is staying busy. A lot of calls since the first of the year. Jackson Hole Radio News is working remotely. Email Jacksonholeradionews@gmail.com. Antler Auction is looking to postpone until the end of summer.
