Re: Total Solar Eclipse Monday August 21st, 2017

The town of Jackson is expecting record numbers of tourists during the week of the solar eclipse. With such a large influx of people, the town is expecting traffic to also be drastically increased. To best serve clients, keep the town clean, and ensure haulers can pick up we have established new Trash Transfer Station and Recycling center hours for the week surrounding the eclipse. The hours for the week of August 19th-25th,2017 are outlined below for both the Trash Transfer Station and Recycling Center. We are highly encouraging haulers to pick up overnight to reduce the amount of traffic on the roads during the day, ease the collection process, and utilize the early morning openings at the Trash Transfer Station.

Trash Transfer Station hours August 19th – 25th, 2017

Saturday August 19th 9am – 3pm

Sunday- CLOSED

Monday, August 21st 1am – 9am (closed to the public)

Tuesday, August 22nd 5am – 3pm

Wednesday, August 23rd 5am – 3pm

Thursday, August 24th 5am-3pm

Friday, August 25th 5am-3pm

Extended hours in the morning (before 7am) are for commercial haulers **only**. The general public will be restricted to normal operating hours. Please inform your customers of the changes in pick up times and to raise awareness of the noise haulers may make during night collections.

Recycling hours August 19th - August 25th, 2017

Saturday, 8/19 - 8am – 3pm

Sunday, 8/20 - CLOSED

Monday, 8/21 - 1am – 9am

Tuesday, 8/22 - 1am – 9am

Wednesday, 8/23 - 1am – 9am

Thursday, 8/24 - 1am – 9am

Friday, 8/25 - 1am – 9am

Saturday, 8/26 - 1am – 9am

Large commercial recycling will be restricted to the hours above. There will not be assistance to unload large commercial recycling during normal business hours. The public and small commercial recyclers may still access the containers at the North entrance during normal business hours.
