## Mission

To guide and assist Teton County Integrated Solid Waste and Recycling achieve this mission of; reduce, reuse, recycle and manage municipal solid waste throughout Teton County, Wyoming, in an efficient and environmentally-sound manner.

## Goals

- Complete landfill closure and plan for post-closure environmental monitoring. Plan and permit the Horsethief Canyon site and facilities that will meet Teton County's current and future solid waste management needs in an efficient, safe, comfortable and environmentally sound manner.
- Maximize current diversion rate of 'tested' commodities and seek new commodities while maintaining fiscal stability to enhance the environmental benefits of diversion, as well as seek further waste stream reduction by adding convenience and incentives.
- Maximize use of human resources.
- Expand and Improve public outreach and interaction
- Plan and implement operations and facilities with a long-range goal of zero waste production in mind.

## Board Purpose

The ISWR Board is an advisory board which proposes policies, rules and regulations, subject to the approval of the County Commission; engage in both long-term and short-term strategic planning; advise on programmatic decisions and policies; propose disposal/recycling rates for the recycling and hazardous waste collection facilities. The ISWR board may create committees/project teams that work independently to provide research and assistance to staff and recommendations to the full board on how to advance major projects. Committees/project teams shall be no more than four members of the ISWR Advisory Board, but also may include members of the public and members of the County and/or Town staff.

Each board member is asked to serve on a committee. Committees include; Education and Outreach/RRR, Zero Waste, Compost Committee, Finance Committee, and Facilities Committee.
