Requirements: Demonstrable expertise in local and regional wildlife ecology, water related environmental sciences, landscapes and vegetation ecology, geological sciences, air quality, or public and regulatory policies pertaining to local government planning and regulatory matters with approximately two experts from each natural science discipline.

Compensation: Members shall serve without compensation
