Joint Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Advisory Board

An advisory board provides non-binding strategic advice to management

## Mission

To plan and construct the Jackson Hole Community Pathways system; improve bicycling and walking conditions on all streets and roads; Enhance community access to quality backcountry trail systems; and institutionalize government and private awareness of the needs of bicyclist, pedestrians, equestrians, and Nordic skiers.

## Goals

1. Improve Facilities
2. Increase Use
3. Enhance Safety
4. Meet the needs of all levels of bicyclists
5. Meet the needs of pedestrians, including persons with disabilities
6. Meet the needs of equestrians
7. Meet the needs of Nordic skiers
8. Increase safety through promoting education and enforcement
9. Encourage and promote bicycling and walking
