

**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Board of County Commissioners, Teton County, WY met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Chambers, **March 15, 2010**, Teton County Administration Building.

Present: Hank Phibbs-Chairman, Ben Ellis, Andy Schwartz, and Paul Vogelheim-Commissioners. Leland Christensen was absent.

Staff: Sherry Daigle, Keith Gingery, Steve Foster, Charlotte Reynolds, and Sandy Birdyshaw.

Chairman Phibbs called the meeting to order at 9:16 a.m.

MATTERS FROM COMMISSION AND STAFF

1. Authorize Payment of the March 8, 2010 Vouchers

Mr. Schwartz moved to approve the March 8, 2010 vouchers in the amount \$763,965.27. Mr. Vogelheim seconded and the Motion passed unanimously.

The Board added the following item for discussion:

Mr. Phibbs stated that on November 17, 2009 he signed a Petition to change the Point of Diversion for the James Boyle No. 3 ditch. The ditch crosses Tribal Trail Road on a portion of Lot 49 in the Indian Springs Ranch subdivision which is owned by Teton County. There was no change in the amount of water available for users of the ditch. Mr. Phibbs asked the Board for a motion to affirm that he signed the Petition on behalf of the Teton County Board of Commissioners, as was requested by the State of Wyoming Board of Control.

Mr. Schwartz moved to affirm that Chairman Phibbs was authorized to sign the Petition on behalf of the Teton County Board of County Commissioners, Mr. Ellis seconded and the Motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was recessed at 9:18 a.m. and reconvened at 11:49 a.m. All five Commissioners were present.
