TO THE VOTERS OF TETON COUNTY, WYOMING:

IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 22-2-109 STATUTES, STATE OF WYOMING ELECTIONS LAWS, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED THAT A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD THROUGH THE 18 ELECTION DISTRICTS AND PRECINCTS OF SAID TETON COUNTY ON **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014**. QUESTIONS TO BE VOTED UPON AT THE GENERAL ELECTION:

FOR JUSTICES OF THE WYOMING SUPREME COURT, FOR A REGULAR TERM OF EIGHT (8) YEARS:
SHALL JUSTICE E. JAMES BURKE BE RETAINED IN OFFICE?
SHALL JUSTICE MICHAEL K. DAVIS BE RETAINED IN OFFICE?

PROPOSED LODGING TAX:

SHALL TETON COUNTY, WYOMING BE AUTHORIZED TO IMPOSE A TWO PERCENT (2) LODGING TAX TO BE USED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: SIXTY PERCENT (60) FOR LOCAL TRAVEL AND TOURISM PROMOTION; THIRTY PERCENT (30) FOR VISITOR IMPACT SERVICES, WHICH INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, PROVISION OF VEHICLE PARKING, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, PUBLIC RESTROOMS, PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PATHWAYS, MUSEUMS AND OTHER DISPLAYS; AND TEN PERCENT (10) TO THE GENERAL FUNDS OF TETON COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF JACKSON?
FOR THE LODGING TAX? AGAINST THE LODGING TAX?

PROPOSED CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX:

SHALL THE TETON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IMPOSE A CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX NOT TO EXCEED ONE (1) MILL ON EACH ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) OF ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN TETON COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SOIL, WATER, WILDLIFE AND OTHER CONSERVATION PROGRAMS AS DIRECTED BY THE TETON CONSERVATION DISTRICT? FOR THE CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX? AGAINST THE CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX?

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A:

THE ADOPTION OF THIS AMENDMENT WOULD ALLOW THE GOVERNOR TO APPOINT NONRESIDENTS OF THE STATE TO SERVE AS UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING TRUSTEES. NOT MORE THAN TWENTY PERCENT (20) OF THE APPOINTED TRUSTEES MAY BE NONRESIDENTS OF THE STATE. THE GOVERNOR WOULD NOT BE REQUIRED TO APPOINT ANY NONRESIDENT AS A TRUSTEE. ALL APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ARE WITH THE ADVICE AND

CONSENT OF THE WYOMING SENATE. FOR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A? AGAINST CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A?

***HOUSE DISTRICT 22 INCLUDES DIST. AND PREC. 1-10 (SOUTH HOBACK) AND 4-1(WILSON SOUTH), 4-3 (WILSON NORTH) IN TETON COUNTY AND PARTS OF LINCOLN COUNTY AND SUBLETTE COUNTY.

AND PREC. 1-1 (SOUTH OF JACKSON), 1-3 (SKYLINE/HI COUNTRY/GROS VENTRE/ELK REFUGE), 1-4 (NORTH JACKSON), 1-11 (INDIAN TRAILS), 1-7 (RAFTER J), 2-1 (KELLY/MOOSE/TETON VALLEY HIGHLANDS/AIRPORT), 3-1 (MORAN/YNP), 4-2 (MOOSE-WILSON ROAD), 4-4 (TETON VILLAGE) AND 5-1 (ALTA) IN TETON COUNTY.

CANDIDATES MUST FILE A STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS BY OCTOBER 28TH, 2014 AND A STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES BY NOVEMBER 14TH, 2014. STATE AND FEDERAL CANDIDATES FILE WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE. COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL CANDIDATES FILE WITH THE COUNTY CLERK. A CANDIDATE WHO FAILS TO FILE A FULL AND COMPLETE ITEMIZED STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES MAY BE CHARGED WITH A MISDEMEANOR AS PROVIDED BY W.S. 22-26-112. A CANDIDATE WHO FAILS TO FILE THE STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS REQUIRED BY THE SEVENTH DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION SHALL HAVE HIS NAME PRINTED ON A LIST DRAFTED BY THE APPROPRIATE FILING OFFICE SPECIFIED UNDER 22-25-107. THE LIST SHALL IMMEDIATELY BE POSTED IN THE FILING OFFICE AND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.

OCTOBER 20, 2014 – LAST DAY TO REGISTER WITH THE COUNTY CLERK BEFORE PRIMARY ELECTION DAY. VOTER REGISTRATION IS ALSO PERMITTED AT THE POLLS ON PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.

NOVEMBER 4, 2014 – GENERAL ELECTION DAY

A LIST OF POLLING PLACES AND SITES FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE.
