

**NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR IMPOSITION OF SALES AND USE TAX  
IN THE GRAND TARGHEE RESORT DISTRICT, TETON COUNTY,  
WYOMING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2014, the Board of Directors for the Grand Targhee Resort District resolved to impose a sales and use tax pursuant to W.S. §§ 39-15-204 and 39-16-204. In accordance with W.S. §§ 39-15-203(a)(iv)(A) and 39-16-203(a)(iii)(A), the Directors further resolved to submit the question of the imposition of the tax to the electors of the District at an election to be held for such purpose.

The election will be the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014. The election will be held by mail ballot. Each qualified elector entitled to vote shall receive a ballot with a return-verification envelope. Ballots will also be mailed to each landowner who has filed a written authorization and request for a mail ballot. If you have not received a ballot ten (10) days before the election and believe you are entitled to vote, please contact the District Secretary at 3300 Ski Hill Road, Alta, Wyoming 83414. The ballot must be returned in the return-verification envelope to the District Secretary, no later than 5 p.m., Mountain Standard Time, on November 25, 2014.

An elector qualified to vote at this election is a person who is a qualified elector or landowner in the District. A landowner includes a person, corporation, partnership or association who owns real property in the District, or who is obligated to pay general property tax under a contract to purchase such real property; provided, however, that the individual who casts the vote for a corporation, partnership or association must present the election official with a written authorization to vote for said entity. A landowner also includes a timeshare owner. Timeshare owners shall have one (1) collective vote for the condominium unit. The one (1) collective vote shall be determined in accordance with the association's bylaws or other governing document or agreement. The vote shall be cast by the person named in a written authorization filed with the election official conducting the election.

Registration pursuant to the general election (or any other) statutes is not required and there shall be no special registration for such election. For the purpose of determining qualifications of electors, the District Secretary may require the execution of an affidavit by any person desiring to vote to evidence his or her qualification therefore. Any elector not otherwise registered who makes an affidavit evidencing his or her qualifications to vote is deemed registered for the election.
