Subject: Consideration of a Grant

Statement / Purpose: To consider a FY2017 grant proposal to Teton County Weed and Pest in the amount of \$3,000 to help fund proper pesticide and herbicide disposal at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility.

Background / Description (Pros & Cons): The grant will provide additional FY2017 funding for the HHW collection program at ISWR's household hazardous waste collection facility, specifically for the proper disposal of unwanted pesticides and herbicides.

Stakeholder Analysis & Involvement: Weed and Pest board and staff; ISWR HHW staff.

Fiscal Impact: The grant proposal is in the amount of \$3,000. No match is required.

Staff Impact: Current staff will be utilized for the HHW program, managing the grant funds and follow up with Weed and Pest.
