



March 17, 2016 Teton LEPC Meeting Minutes

- I. **Call to Order** – Rich Ochs called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.
- II. **Approval of January LEPC Meeting Minutes** - Mary Lou made a motion to approve the January meeting minutes, Travis seconded the motion. All approved.
- III. **Around the room introductions were made.**
- IV. **Training and Exercise Plan Update** - Rich Ochs reviewed upcoming events. This Saturday is the Zac Brown concert. This event will run under incident command. They are expecting 16k people. It will be a unified command. Next week is Hill Climb and a flood table top. The week after is a fire table top then Rachel has a point of distribution pod exercise. - V. **Tier II Reporting Summary and Review** – Rich Ochs reviewed a Tier II presentation which included emergency planning community right to know act, who must report under EPCRA, what is reported, what is not reported, 2015 Outreach, how we map threat zones for chlorine and BLEVE threat zone, Tier II reporting trends from 2011 to 2015, Tier II reporting by sector, 2015 Tier II reported chemicals, 2015 Tier II facilities by response zone, chemicals by response zone, threat zone facility summary, threat zone population summary, threat zone analysis, looked into 2016 and answered questions.
- VI. **Around the Table** – Nick with TCEM is working on mutual aid agreements BTNF, Caribou Forest, Search and Rescue, Fire Department and the Sheriff Office. Licenses are assigned to individual departments. We need to get signed agreements from each facility for FCC to use frequencies. Nick will be contacting agencies. Cindy is the new Teton County PIO and is looking forward to working with everyone. Travis with the forest service is working to get MSDS online, getting up

to date with GHS. Hopefully this project completed by the end of summer and will send out links to the information. Joseph with TSA noted that the airport is up 13% year to date. CDC wants them post signs for the Zika virus, TSA will post warning. Bill with TVPW has the Rendezvous this weekend, Teton Village has a few trainings coming up in the next few months. Rev. Bott with TC VOAD is working on expanding the volunteer base. Regional and state conferences coming up. Fred with CERT had one call out for the rehab team recently. They did a night training session with lights and generators with the rehab bus. Jackson Hole Fire/EMS donated bunker gear to LEPC and it was distributed. April 1st is the next news letter. Fred reminded everyone to wash their hands frequency. You can catch bacteria from pets and he may have caught it stacking firewood. Mary Lou from Red Cross distributed 40 smoke alarms. The office in Casper is trying to get a Red Cross youth program organized. Big news is on April 30th in cooperation with homeland security there will be a train the trainer. Terry with TC Dispatch is implementing internal after action reviews in writing. Cole with Jackson Police Dept. has been focusing on the budget process which is challenging with state cuts. Next week is Hill Climb. There will be a lot of people in town the next two week. Jess at Search and Rescue mentioned the helicopter will be here until the end of May. Might use it for SLAM at the high school. SLAM is put on once every 4 years. Also, Jess applied for a grant with homeland security that provides equipment for people with dementia. Hopefully, buying equipment in the next few weeks. They will be reaching out to other agencies. Jess thanked everyone that helped support this. Jenny introduced herself, she just started with EM and is excited to be here.
