- I. **Call to Order** – Rich Ochs called the meeting to order at 0830
- II. **Approval of May LEPC Meeting Minutes** – Battalion Chief Coe made a motion to approve last meeting minutes. Eve Lynes seconded the motion. All approved.
- III. **September JH Airport Exercise** – This table top exercise has been changed to September 23 from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
- IV. **Training and Exercise Calendar Update** - Rachael updated everyone on the upcoming trainings. Hazmat and Hazmat Ops are in August, Table top is changed to September 23rd. The hospital is planning an active shooter exercise in October. Check calendar for updates and all trainings

- V. **Multi Hazard Mitigation Plan** –Barb Beck - Outlines the different Hazards. Hoping to have a draft this fall to present to the Town Council and Teton County Commissioners. Barb passed out a quiz. Everyone took a few minutes to complete then reviewed all of the answers and discussed. Reviewed the 7 question survey results from the last LEPC meeting. This survey was also passed out at a public meeting. Reviewed the survey and answers and differences between the LEPC group and at the Public meeting. Passed out Goal One Projects List Handout. This will be part of the public document. If the project is listed it makes it easier to apply for funding. Three goals: 24 projects for the County, 7 for the Town and 4 for the Conservation District. 35 total projects. Reviewed every project and updated

priorities. Handed out another form summarizing what the public identified as hazards, issues or concerns and potential mitigation for concern. Reviewed/discussed this hazard list and added certain items to the Project list. Draft will be out in August and sent to LEPC for updates.

- VI. **Around the Table** – Fred Whissel/CERT - Published the nine page CERT letter. Tuesday night they had a second meeting assisting Fire/EMS. CERT has set up the new bus providing relief services. August will be the annual picnic. BC Clay will be doing a training. Late September or October CERT will try to start another training class. They have 80 people on waiting list. Jon Bishop/TVFD & JHMR – There are record setting visitations at the Village this summer. Recently did a training for summer evacuations on the gondola. Did the same table top exercise that Rich Ochs did last time. TVFD has been pretty quiet. Charlotte Reynolds/TC PIO – Offered acknowledgement and appreciation to the information support for helping with the missing teenagers. Rachael Levitz at TC Public Health – Working on a coordinated flu vaccine program with pharmacies, hospitals etc. Mary Lou Klene/Red Cross – Still waiting on new trailer. Red Cross has three programs going. Two of their people went to Lusk, WY to help. It was good thing Red Cross stayed on scene in Lusk. They basically set up an incident command center for damage assessment and sheltering. Red Cross is still here in Jackson. They do not have a local office anymore and work out of the EOC. Joseph Sebastian/Airport – Inbound Flights are up 4%. The new structure is doing well. Cyber security/Opium breach - identity theft is a huge issue. Sign up for alerts on your credit cards. Cyber security is one the biggest things. Steve Markason/BTNF – Fire apparatus are out. Teton to Snake fuels project is drafted and in the last edit. It will be out Tuesday. When the grasses dry out later this summer it will be fire season. Lloyd Funk/Sheriff Office – The parents of the missing teenagers were very impressed with the services. Spread the word about identity theft. Alyssa Watkins/TC Administrator – Working on several large items now. We are down to 4 Commissioners. Hoping for candidate names next week. BC Coe/JH Fire/EMS – Information from some of these data streams should be accessible. RERT sent a bomb team for training in Casper in June. Also, attended EBOLA training in June. We will have a Decon kit at Public Health and utilize with the RERT team. New propane props will be initiated for Fire Fighters and First Responders. Hoping to have this live in September and have trainings. This was a Homeland Security purchase. JH Fire/EMS is very busy. We have two new hires up and running. This will help us respond to the increased call volume. Working with 12 new volunteers getting them up speed. Rich Ochs E/M – Received approval for a part time hire. Working on the job description now. It will be 30 hrs per week. Bill has submitted his resignation. He will be leaving in September. We will be looking for a communications coordinator as well. Both positions will be advertised regionally and nationwide.
