As defined by IWUIC 2012 edition, **defensible space** is an area either natural or manmade, where material capable of allowing a fire to spread unchecked has been treated, cleared or modified to slow the rate and intensity of an advancing wildfire and to create an area for fire suppression operations to occur. Further defined, trees and structures, overhead electrical facilities or unmodified fuel is not less than 10 feet.

Using the above definition, what distance of defensible space can be established from the proposed structure?
