



Storage of Firewood and Combustible materials

Firewood should be kept in a neat stack away from combustible materials. Ashes should be placed in a metal container with a tight fitting lid.

BBQ grills should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and over hanging branches.

Keep weeds and grasses low and out from under the home or decks. Clean leaves and debris from gutters, eaves, porches and decks. Remove dead and down trees, limbs, brush, needles etc....

The vegetation surrounding a building or structure is fuel for fire. Even the building or structure itself is considered fuel. Research and experience have shown that fuel reduction around a building or structure increases the probability of it surviving a wildfire, Good defensible space allows firefighters to protect and save structures safely.

Remove garbage in a timely manner and don't let it accumulate.

Clean the lint filter before and after each load of laundry. Remove lint that has collected around the drum. Keep the area around your dryer clear of things that can burn, like boxes, cleaning supplies and clothing.
